New interdisciplinary master courses about the sea and society

Are you interested in how the human society is linked to the marine environment and the ecosystem? Do you want to be a part of Sweden's most complete environment for marine and maritime research and education?

The University of Gothenburg offers two new interdisciplinary courses at master's level.

The University of Gothenburg is Sweden's most complete environment for marine and maritime research and education. Located along the Swedish west coast, the university has close collaboration with several national marine and maritime industries, authorities and regulatory bodies such as the Swedish Agency for Marine and Water Management.

In 2019, the University of Gothenburg will start a new international, interdisciplinary master program (Master in Sea and Society) for students that want a broad marine education as training for a career in marine/maritime industry, marine authorities, environmental courts and multidisciplinary marine sciences. The two first courses of the program are now available as individual courses for the fall semester of 2018.
